Welcome to JITC's Joint Interoperability Tool (JIT) Tour. The JIT stores test results for JITC, to include JITC Test Reports, Certification and Assessment letters, and various references. The tool allows a user to locate data quickly and easily through a high-speed search engine.

## How to Access the JIT?

**SIPRNET Users** – Please visit: <http://jit.jitc.disa.smil.mil>

This is a SIPRNET address and cannot be accessed via the NIPRNET (INTERNET). Please note that the SIPRNET JIT does not require a user account (i.e., username and password). Access to the SIPRNET JIT is open to all cleared personnel with access to a SIPRNET workstation.

## NIPRNET Users

**Applying for Access** – Please visit: <http://jit.fhu.disa.mil> as shown in Figure 1.

Click on "Apply for a User Account." Fill out the requested fields completely and click the "Submit Request" Button. A confirmation page with a newly assigned username and password will display. Please remember this information. **IMPORTANT:** The assigned username and password will NOT be active concluding the application session. A Designated Approval Authority will review each application and notify the applicant via email as to the status of his/her request. Upon acceptance and notification, the account will be active. Average turnaround time is two business days or less.

The heart of the system is an extensive data repository featuring the JITC Lessons Learned reports, JITC Test Reports, Joint Interoperability Certification letters, and other interoperability documents and references; as well as a high speed search engine to quickly access data.

This tool gives a quick and easy on-line capability which identifies system/equipment characteristics, tested configurations and practical "how-to" information to facilitate interoperability.



**Logging into the JIT** – To access the JIT, from <http://jit.fhu.disa.mil>, click on “Enter the Joint Interoperability Tool” with the approved account information. Client Authentication is required. Select the correct Certificate, and next enter the pin code as shown in Figure 2. **IMPORTANT:** Users may click “View Certificate” to ensure they DO NOT inadvertently select the wrong certificate (i.e. email).

**Requesting Account Information** – Click on “Request Account Information.” Fill out the form completely and click the “Submit Request” button to request user information or to verify account status, as shown in Figure 3.






Figure 6. Test Reports

*Test Reports* – Lists numerous test reports organized by type as in Figure 6.




Figure 7. Certification Letters

*Certification Letters* – Provides a complete listing of certifications since Fiscal Year 1994. The more recent certification summaries (FY96 and on) include the certification letters and testing summaries as shown in Figure 7.

**New on the JIT** – Provides links to new JIT documents and updates posted within the last six months, as shown in Figure 8.

**Quick Search** – Helps a user rapidly find information on the JIT. A user may search using keywords or concepts as shown in Figure 9. To begin, enter a keyword(s) or equipment classification inside the query box, and click the “go” button. Next, select a document you wish to view based on the document summary. The selected document can then be viewed, including links and graphics.

**The JIT Menu Options** – Provides links to Reports, Projects, References, Tools, Contact Information, and Visitor Information, as shown in Figure 10.

*Reports* – provides access to JITC’s Test Reports and Certification Letters (also available on the home page), as well as various data repositories and lessons learned.

*Projects* – includes various projects at JITC, available through the JIT.

*References* – provides access to a variety of standards, instructions, guidance and directives.

*Tools* – includes various JITC project and JIT website utilities.

*Contact Info* – provides a variety of channels to contact the locations, representatives and provide feedback.

*Visitor Info* – includes information about JITC’s Commander and Deputy Commander.
