

Subject: Interim Certificate to Operate (ICTO) for the Advanced
Console System, Siemens HiPath 4300 Switch

Reference: CJCSI 6212.01B, Interoperability and Supportability of
National Security Systems, and Information Technology
Systems

1. In accordance with the authority provided by the reference, the Interoperability Test Panel (ITP) has reviewed and concurs with your request for an Interim Certificate to Operate (ICTO) with respect to the Siemens HiPath 4300 Switch. Concurrence of this ICTO is based upon the current operational requirements you have identified.
2. The ITP Chairman concurs with the recommendations of the Joint Interoperability Test Command (JITC) and the ITP members, and grants an ICTO for use of the HiPath 4300 Switch at the 12th Flying Training Wing/HQ Air Education and Training Command, Randolph AFB, Texas.
3. This ICTO is effective beginning 11 September 2003 and expires on 20 March 2004 to be consistent with existing HiPath 4000 ICTOs for other locations.
4. This ICTO is subject to the following conditions:
 - a. The USAF continues to work to ensure the HiPath 4300 vendor resolves identified interoperability problems.
 - b. If at the end of this ICTO, the HiPath 4300 has not been joint interoperability test certified, it will be considered a candidate for disconnect from DSN.
