SUBJECT: Interim Certificate to Operate (ICTO) for the Electronic Wahl System Digital (EWSD) Switch Remote Switching Unit (RSU) Release 19

Reference: CJCSI 6212.01B, Interoperability and Supportability of National Security Systems, and Information Technology Systems


1. In accordance with the authority provided by the reference, the Interoperability Test Panel (ITP) has reviewed and concurs with your request for an Interim Certificate to Operate (ICTO) extension with respect to the Electronic Wahl System Digital (EWSD) Remote Switching Unit (RSU) Release 19. The concurrence is based upon consideration of the risk to the DSN and current operational needs.

2. The ITP Chairman considering operational needs and risks, concurs with the recommendations of the Joint Interoperability Test Command (JITC) and the ITP members to grant an ICTO for use of the EWSD Switch RSU Release 19 at the 30 sites in Europe listed in enclosure (1). This ICTO is effective beginning on 1 February 2004 and expires on 30 May 2004. This ICTO is being issued as an administrative extension to the EWSD RSU ICTO dated 3 December 2003 that expired on 30 January 2004 and modifies the EWSD RSUs covered to only those identified in enclosure (1). This extension is being granted to allow for completion of Joint Certification testing with JITC. Testing can now be scheduled and completed since the Joint Staff has granted a GSCR MLPP waiver for the EWSD in the Stand-Alone Mode for these 30 sites.

3. This ICTO is subject to the following conditions:

If, at the end of this ICTO, the EWSD RSU (RSU) Release 19 has not been joint interoperability certified or granted an ICTO extension by the ITP, it shall be considered as a candidate for disconnect from DSN.
