MEMORANDUM FOR ESC/DN13, ATTN: Lt COL ANTHONY CERVENY

SUBJECT: Interim Certificate to Operate (ICTO) for AN/TSQ-214(V) Joint Air Defense System Integrator (JADSI) software Version 12.1.0

1. In accordance with the authority provided by the reference, the Interoperability Test Panel (ITP) concurs with your request for an Interim Certificate to Operate (ICTO) with respect to the Joint Air Defense System Integrator (JADSI), Version 12.1.0. The ITP bases concurrence with this ICTO on your identified urgent operational requirement to field this system.
2. The ITP Chairman concurs with the recommendations of the Joint Interoperability Test Command (JITC) and the ITP members, and grants an ICTO for use of the JADSI, Version 12.1.0. This ICTO is effective beginning 15 July 2004 and expires on 30 January 2005.
3. This ICTO is subject to the following conditions:
 - a. Only applies to the following sets of capabilities:
 - 1). Link 11/11B Transmit/Receive/Forward (Military Standard (MIL-STD) 6011C).
 - 2). Link 11/11B/16 Forward (MIL-STD-6016C and MIL-STD-6020).
 - 3). Link 16 Transmit/Receive (Joint Tactical Information Distribution System/Multifunctional Information Distribution System Line of Sight (MIL-STD-6016C).
 - 4). Link 16 (Joint Range Extension Application Protocol C Version 1, User Datagram Protocol Unicast (MIL-STD-3011).
 - b. That the Air Force is to continue efforts to document the NR-KPP for JADSI and achieve Joint Staff certification of those interoperability requirements.
 - c. That the Air Force brief the September ITP on progress toward full certification for all versions of JADSI.

d. If, at the end of this ICTO, the JADSI, 12.1.0 has not been joint interoperability certified, the ITP will consider it a candidate for removal from operational use.
