MEMORANDUM FOR UNITED STATES JOINT FORCES COMMAND (JFCOM),
BRANCH 86 ATTN: MR. CHARLES TRIPLETT

Subject: Interim Certificate to Operate (ICTO) for the Joint Enroute Mission Planning
and Rehearsal System-Near Term (JEMPRS-NT)

1. In accordance with the authority provided by reference, the Interoperability Test Panel (ITP) concurs with your request for an Interim Certificate to Operate (ICTO) with respect to the Joint Enroute Mission Planning and Rehearsal System-Near Term (JEMPRS-NT). The ITP bases this concurrence upon your urgent operational requirement to field this system.
2. The ITP Chairman concurs with the recommendations of the Joint Interoperability Test Command (JITC) and the ITP members to grant an ICTO to the JEMPRS-NT while the JITC is completing interoperability certification testing. This ICTO is effective beginning 24 September 2004 and expires on 31 March 2005. The ITP is issuing this ICTO as an administrative extension to the JEMPRS-NT dated 16 June 2004 that expired 30 September 2004.
3. This ICTO is subject to the following conditions:
 - a. JFCOM is to provide a brief of ISP status as well as identification of tests scheduled, at the 19 NOV 2004 ITP Meeting.
 - b. If, at the end of this ICTO, JEMPRS-NT has not been joint interoperability certified, the ITP will consider it a candidate for removal from operational use.
