

Web-enabled J-RAD Login Instructions for first-time users

- * Use Internet Explorer

 - * The J-RAD uses the JDMT interface.
1. Link to J-RAD Login Page: <https://jiticweb4.fhu.disa.mil/JDMT/login.asp>
 2. The site will have a popup asking for your CAC credentials similar to when you first open IE. This will happen each time you login to J-RAD.
 3. You've reached the J-RAD Login Page.
 4. "J-RAD – JITC Risk Assessment Database" should already be populated in the **Project Site** dropdown.
 5. Your name (**First.Last**) should already be in the "UserID (CAC)" field.
 6. Select "CAC" Login.
 7. Go to the next page of these instructions.


