

## **JCPAT-E Search for J6 Certified Requirements Documents**

Control Number: 10-002

CJCSI 6212.01 requires that interoperability test certifications be based on J-6 certified requirements documents. The linked briefing provides detailed guidance, to the mouse click level, for obtaining these documents from the Joint C4I Program Assessment Tool-Empowered (JCPAT-E) repository.

Target audience is Action Officers, test team members, and anyone else involved in producing and reviewing test plans and interoperability test certification/assessment documents. Secondary audience is supervisory personnel supervising the primary audience.

Current templates for JITC certification letters require key elements of information from JCPAT-E to record that the correct requirements documents, obtained from the correct source, were used as the basis for testing and certification. This briefing covers where to look for these elements.

Key points covered in this briefing include:

- Getting a JCPAT-E account
- Search techniques
- Fine points of identifying the correct documents from search results
- Getting JCPAT-E system registration numbers (required entries in interoperability test certification memos, not to be confused with JCPAT-E document control numbers which are also required entries)
- Drilling down to the J-6 certification memo
- Accessing and downloading the actual documents
- Finding Technical Views (TV-1 and TV-2) in the DISROnline tool
